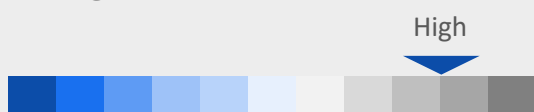
## STRATEGY

3. Maximize tax efficiency by having a low portfolio turnover ratio.

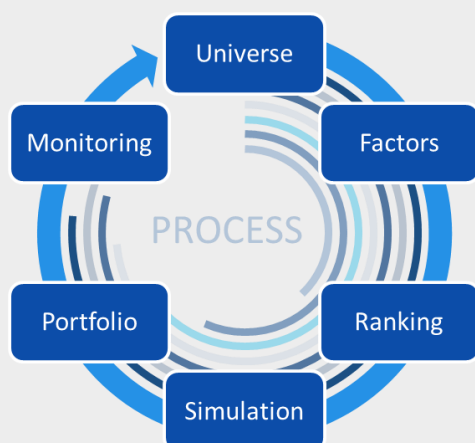

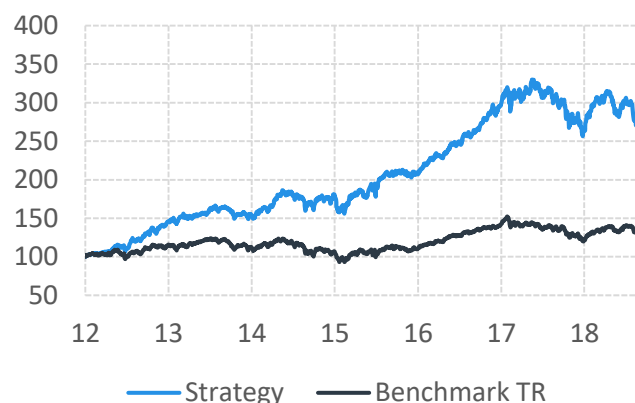
