

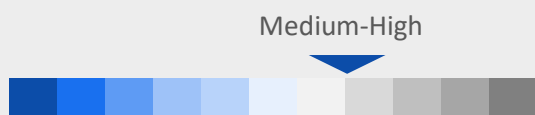
## STRATEGY

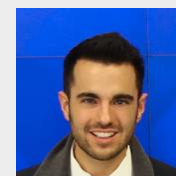
