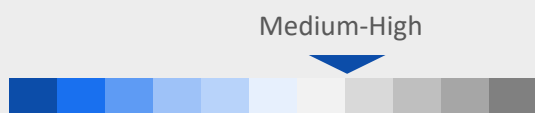
STRATEGY

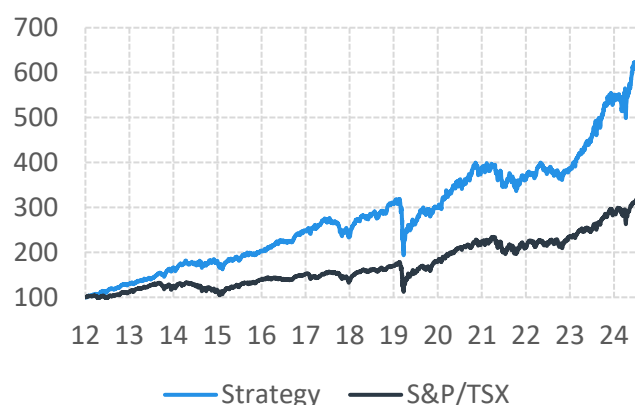

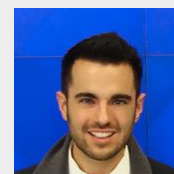
