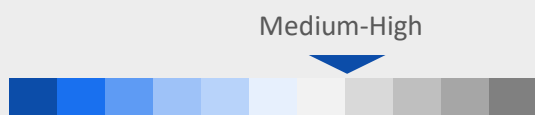
STRATEGY

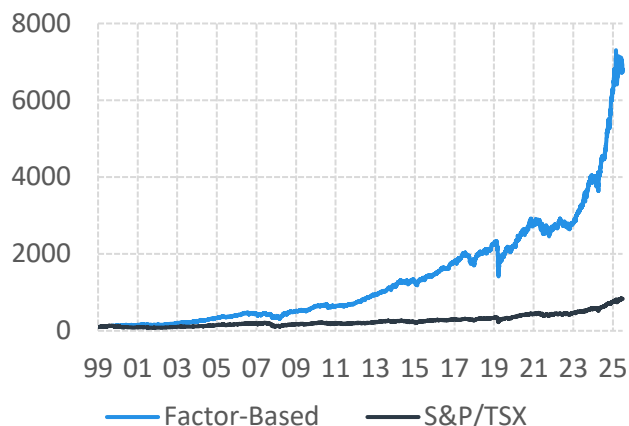
