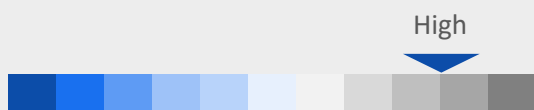
STRATEGY

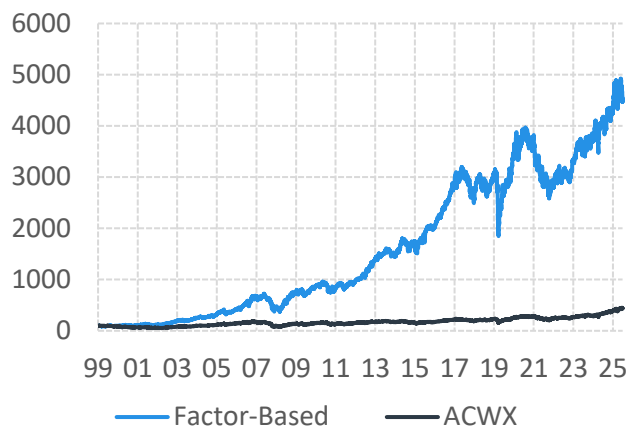
